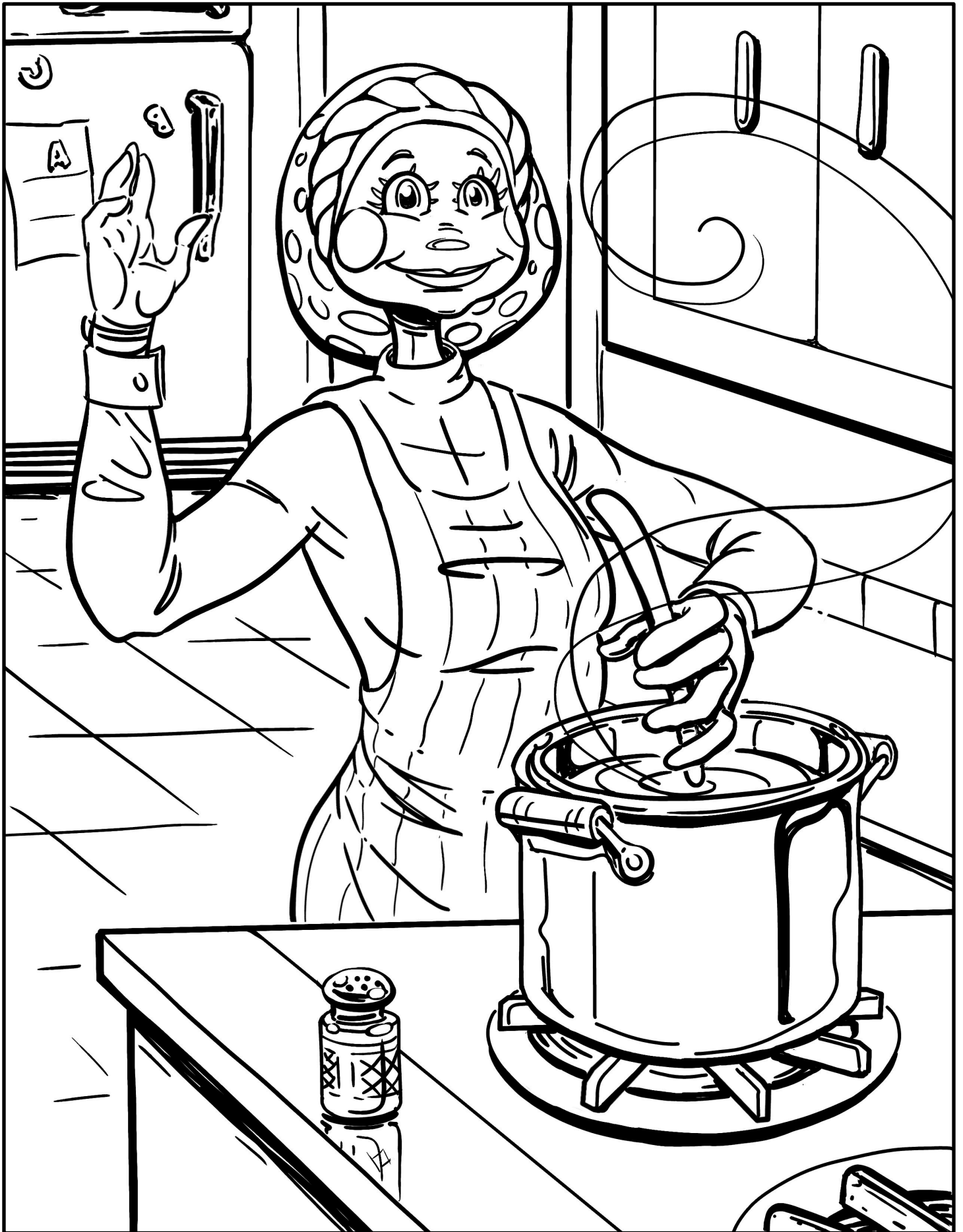

Moishy laughed as the baby clapped, “More! More!”



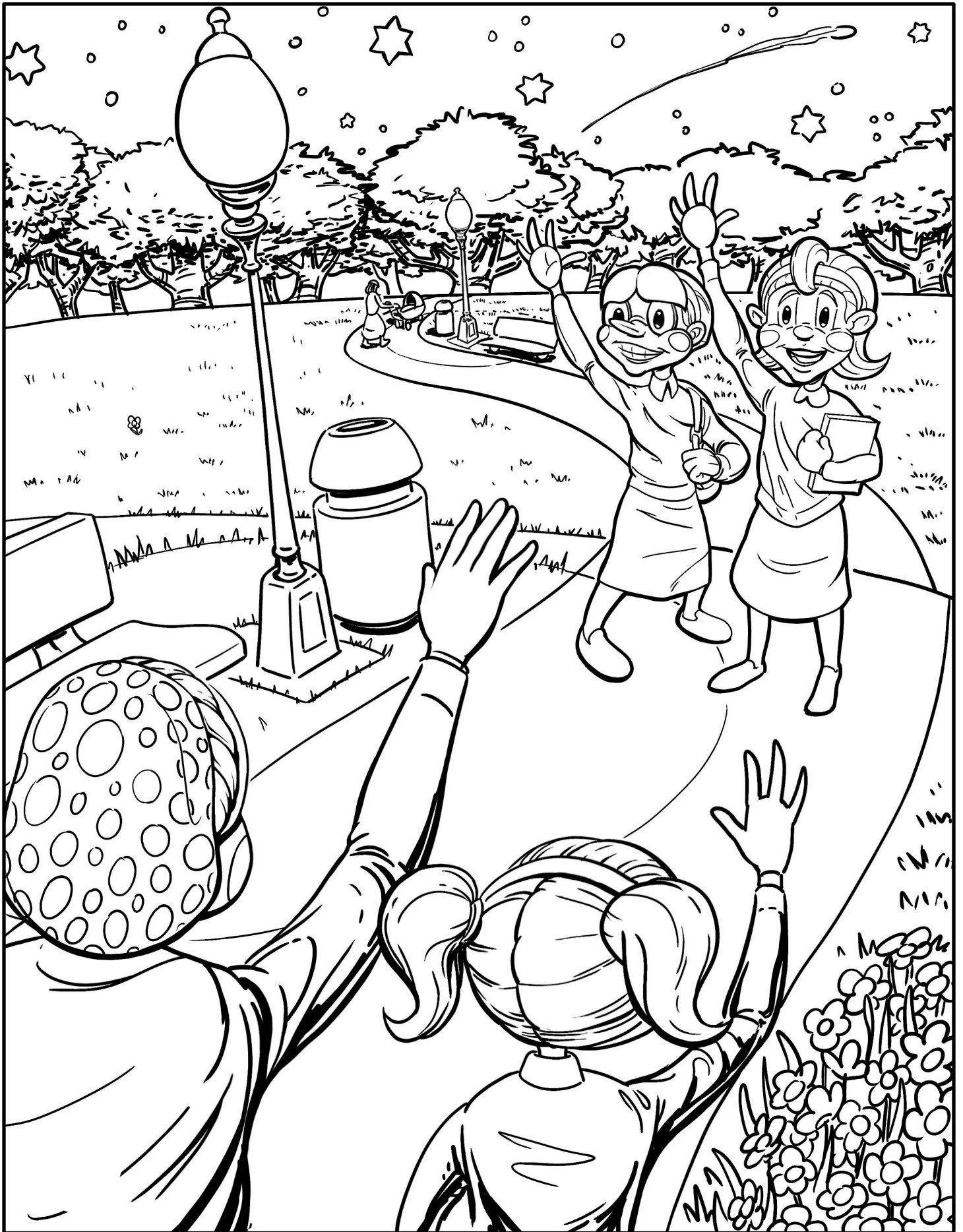
“Just imagine,” said Raizel, “if they came every day!”

They always made jokes and helped everyone!



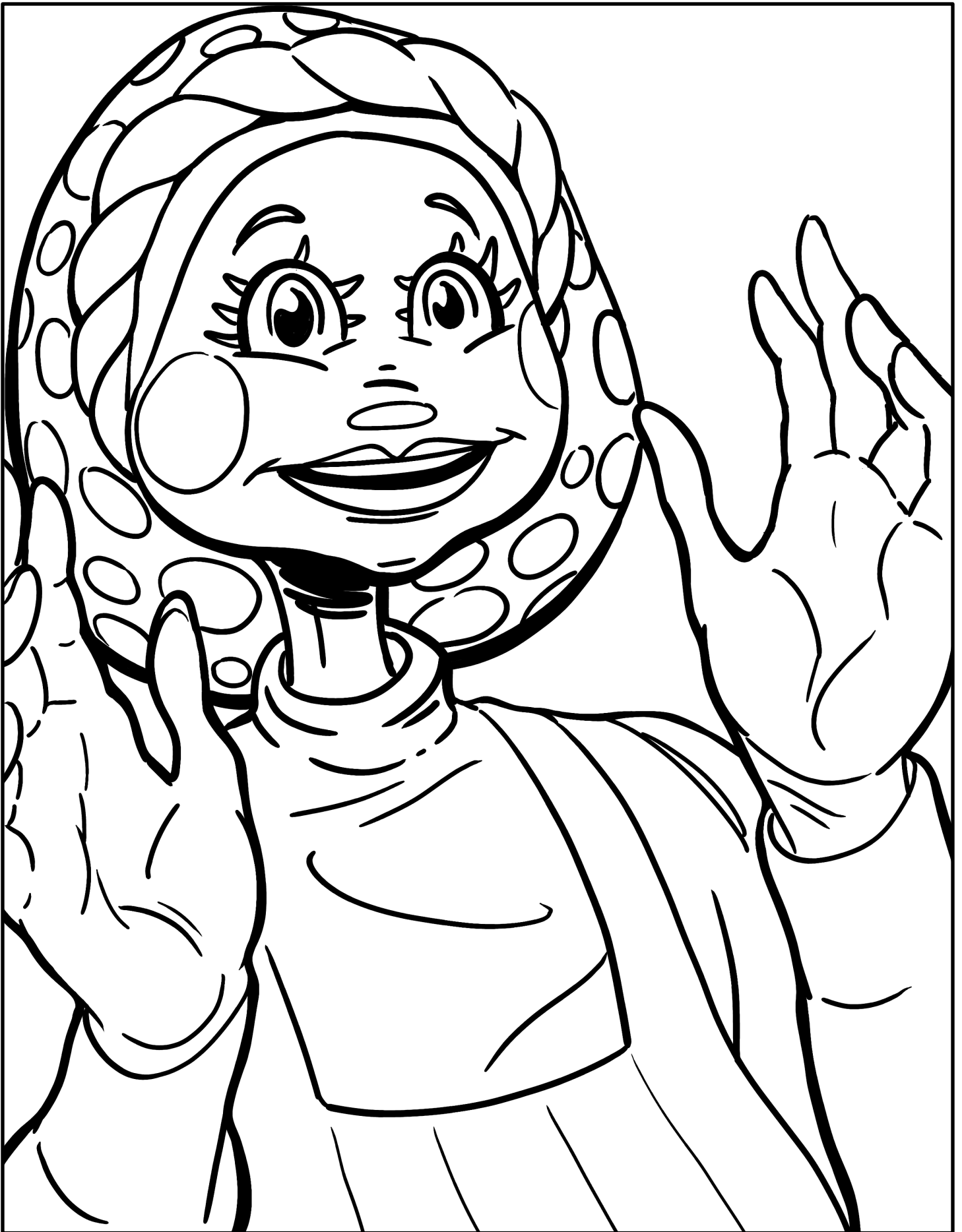
They would color and bake and go to the park,
They'd come when it's light, and leave when it's dark!



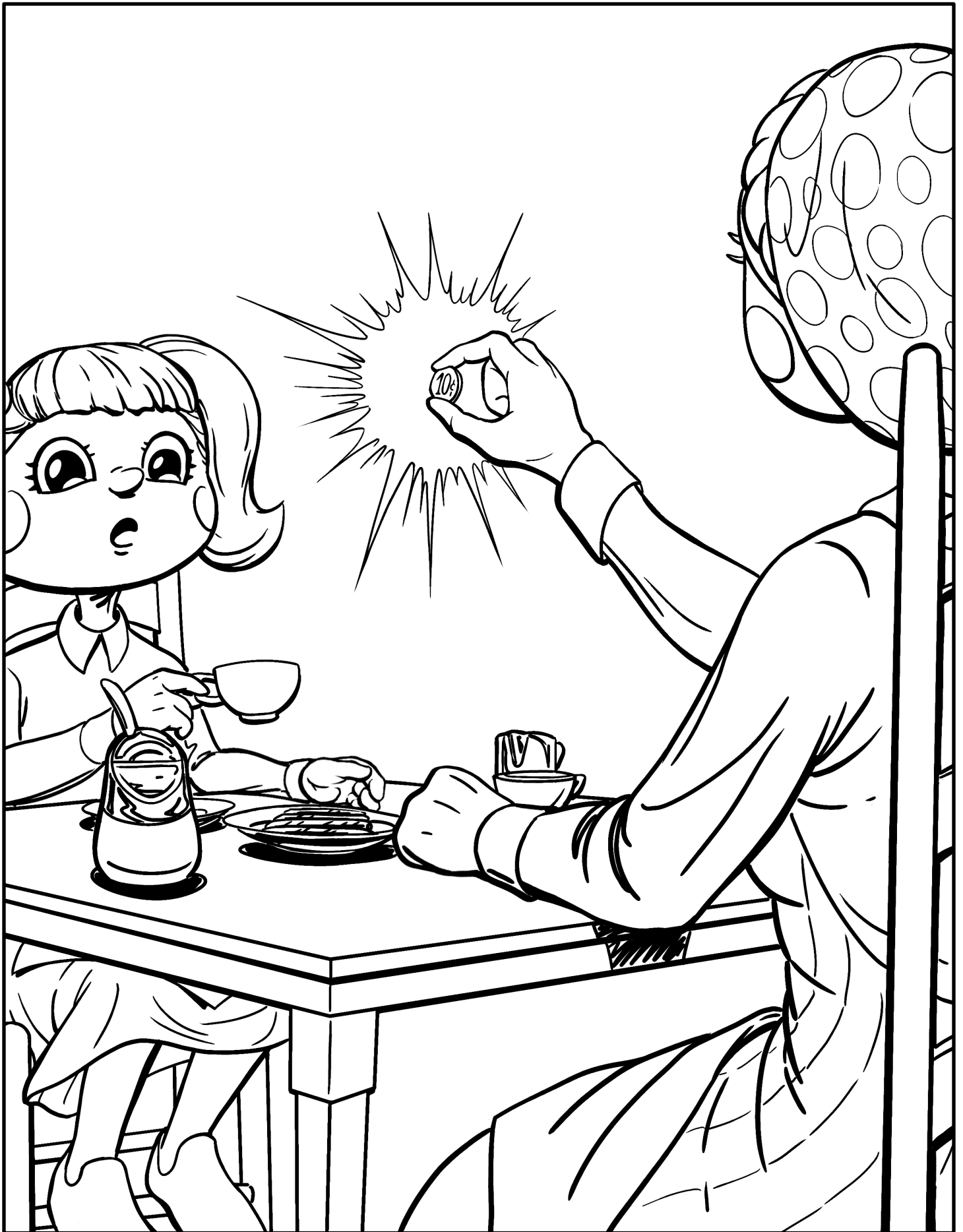
“Indeed, we’re so lucky,” Mommy said to all them,
“For our special friends, we must thank Hashem!”



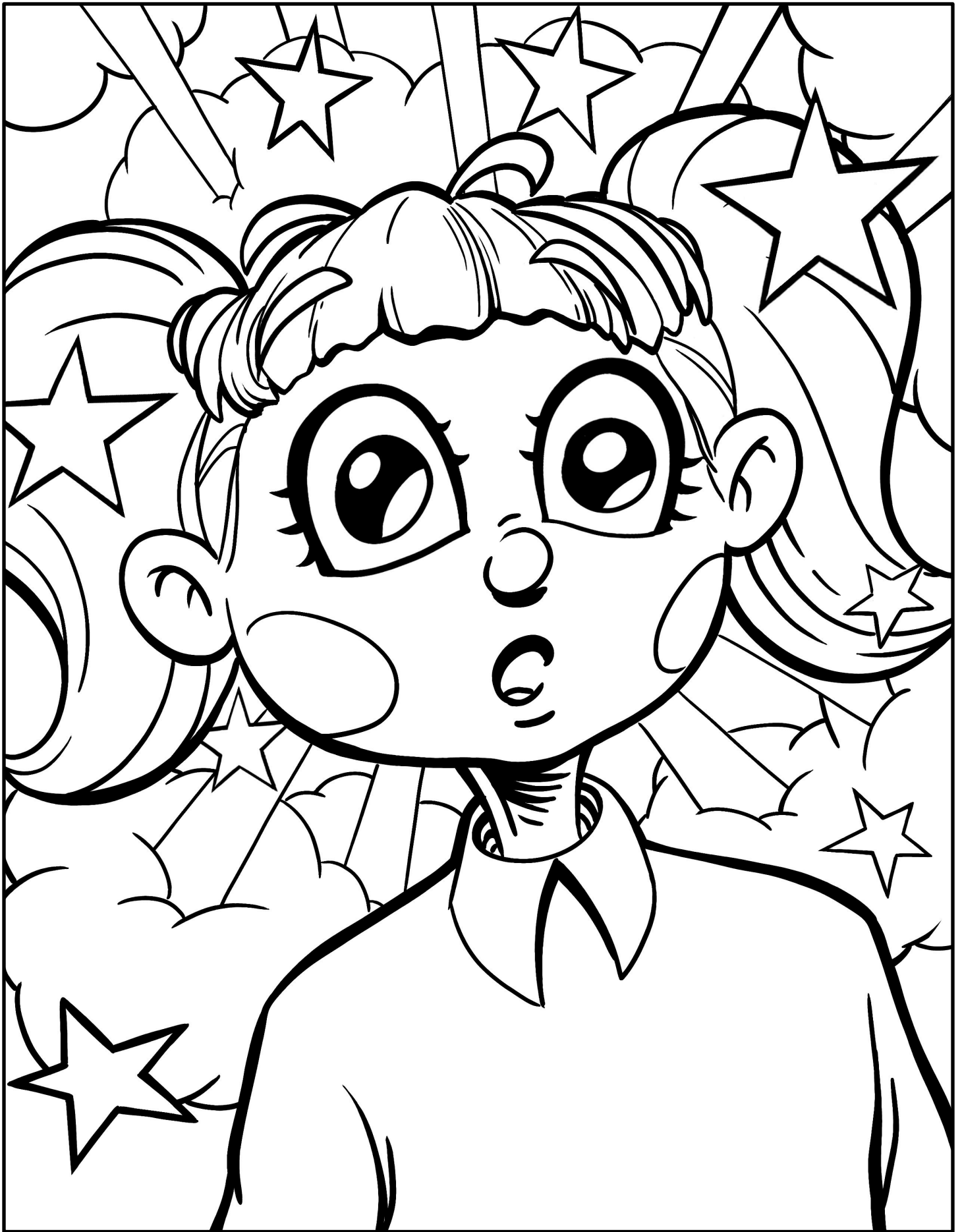
“They probably get paid a thousand dollars,” Chassie said,

Why give up their time every week on Tuesday?”



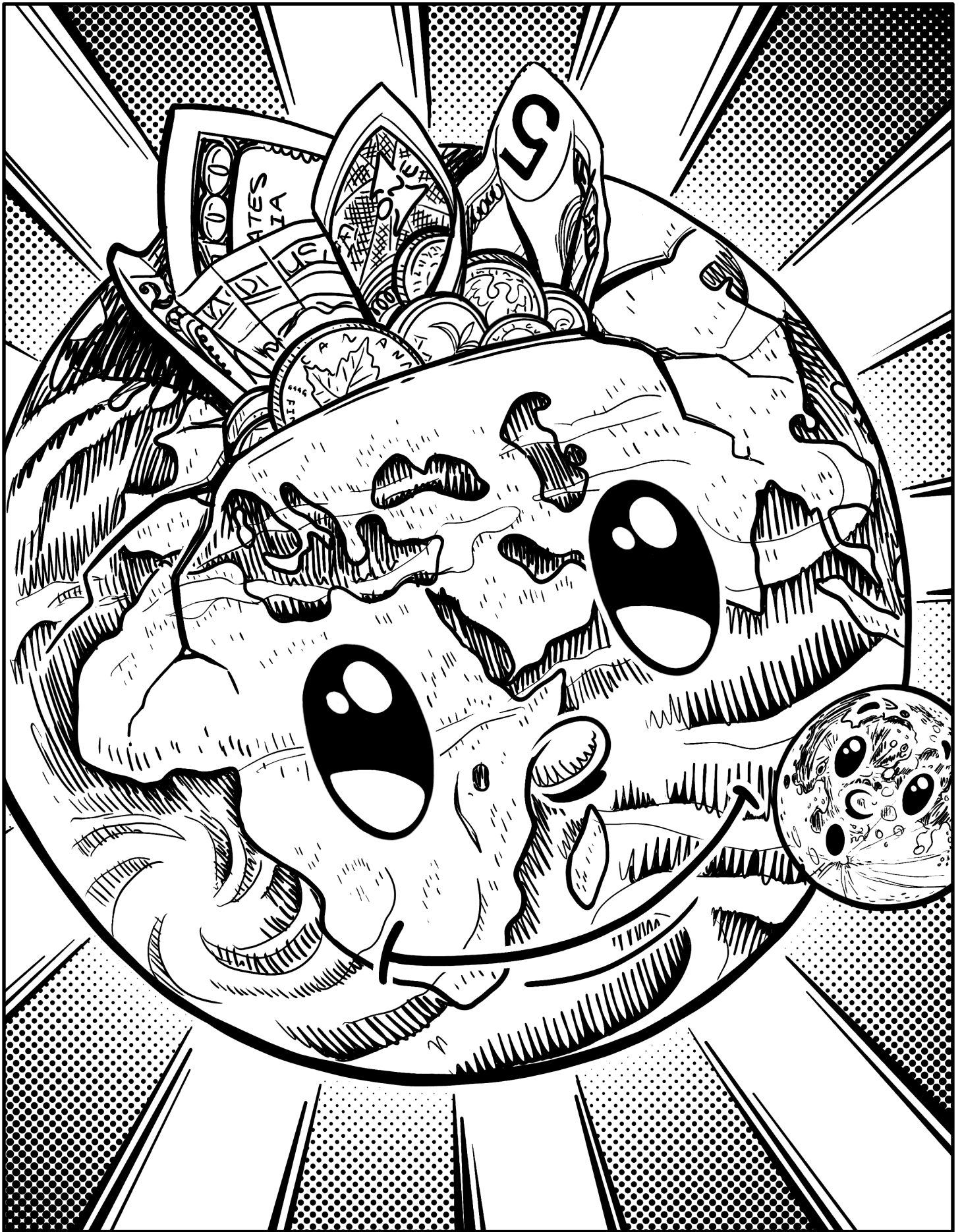
Chassie was shocked; it made no sense in her mind,
Why would these girls be so generous and kind??



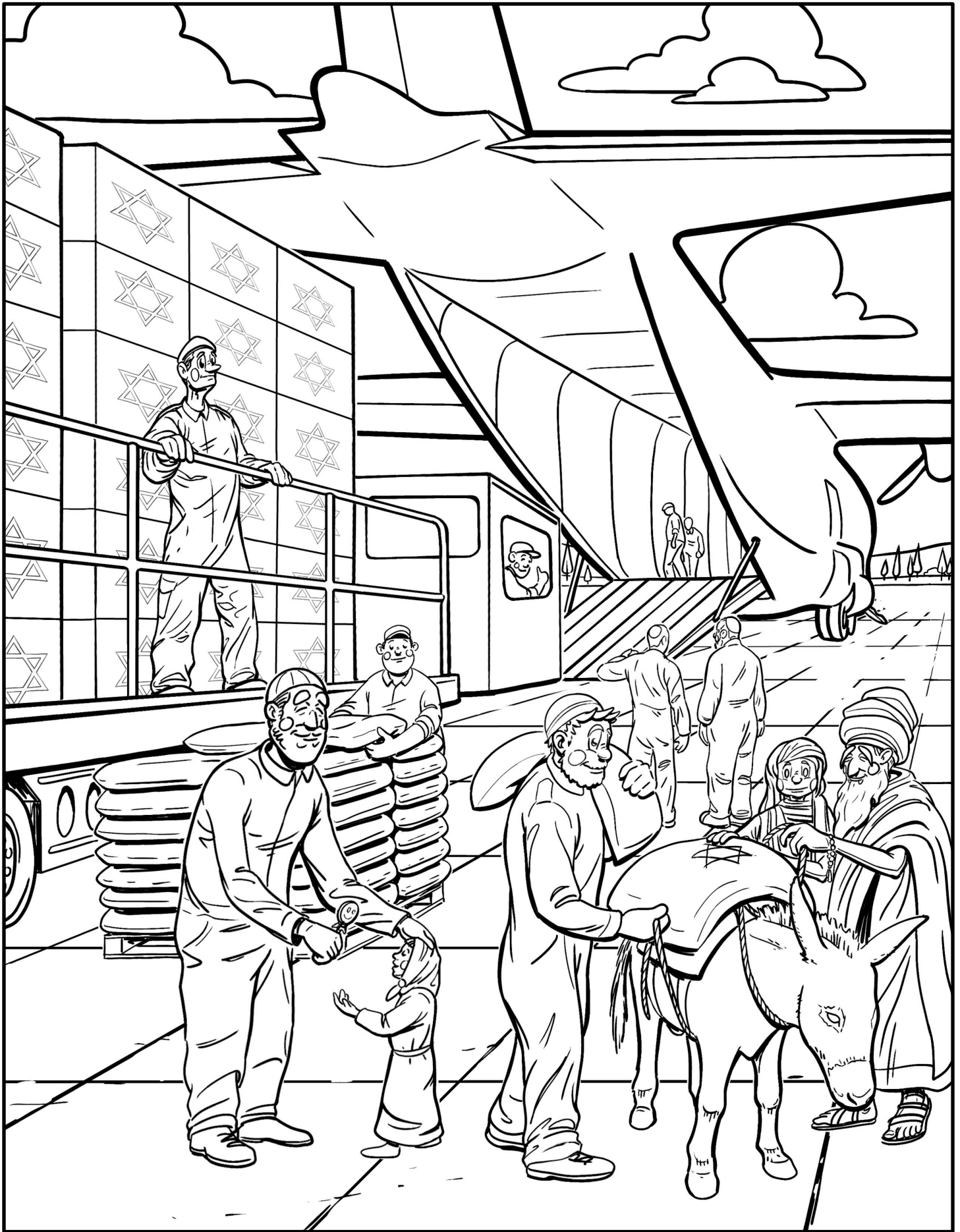
“It’s all about Chessed, doing good for another,
Remembering that each Yid is our sister or brother,



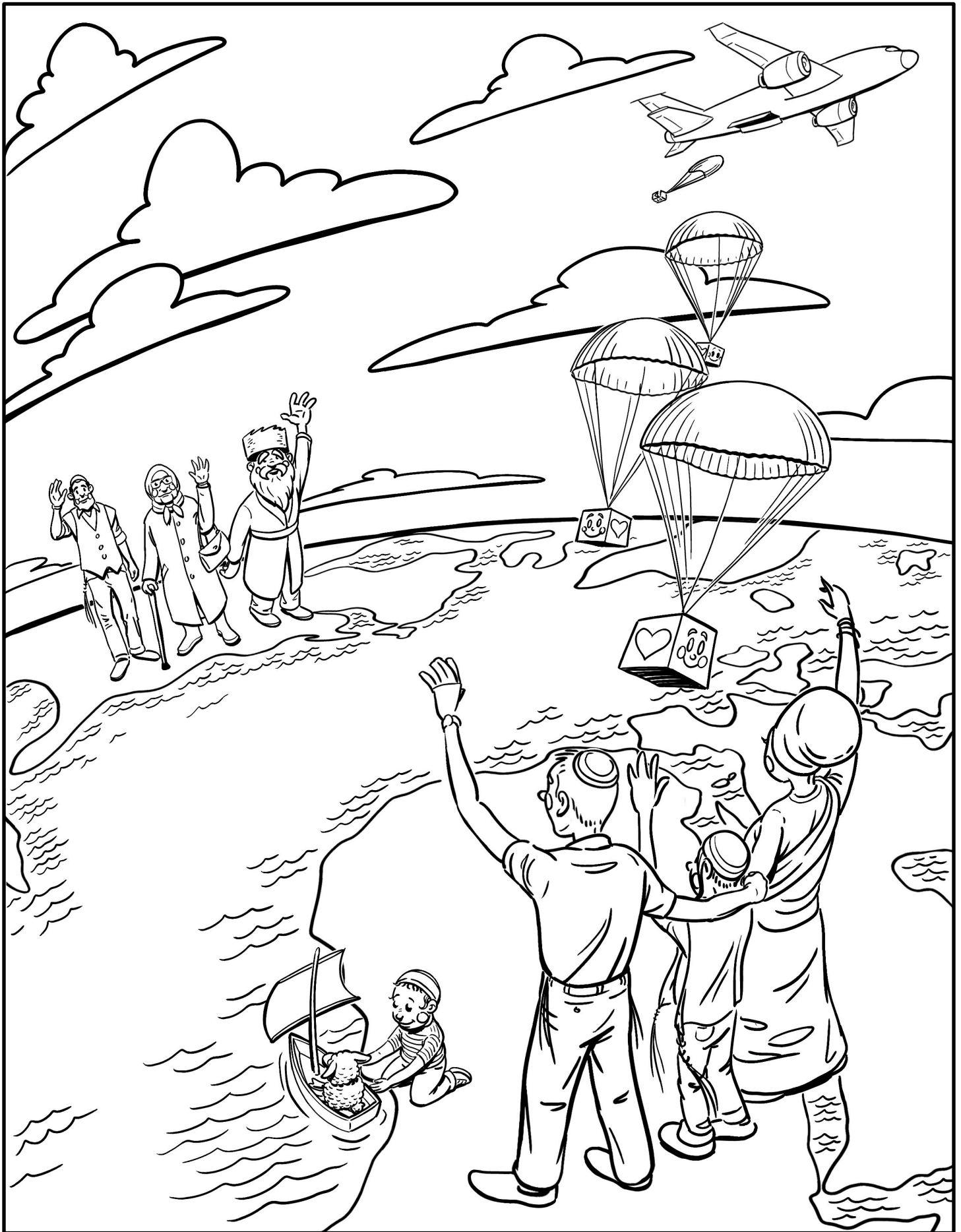
Avraham Avinu, who is the father of us all
