To that end, our classes in Chumash, Likutei Sichos, and Hebrew language are divided by skill level, not by grade. Students from any background can find the proper fit and grow from there. Through guided chavrusah learning, we provide our students with the grounding they need to take charge of their own learning.

We believe strongly that the focus of Judaics is inspiration as much as education, and to facilitate this, we offer a range of classes in Chassidic texts, from Sichos that correspond to the portion of Chumash students are studying, to Tanya and Ma'amarim. Together, these courses imbue practical applications of Chassidic principles into daily life.



GENERAL STUDIES

The goal of our high school program is to prepare students with the life and academic skill set they need for whatever their future may bring. To this end, we provide a college-preparatory program that enables students to graduate with the knowledge that they will succeed at continuing their academic growth. We accomplish this with help from our fully equipped science lab, AP courses, robotics and coding classes, and participation in arts and writing competitions.

The school has an array of Chromebooks, Zoom Rooms, and SmartBoards to enable engaging and rigorous instruction. We assign students Yeshiva School email addresses, have filters and whitelists, and monitor student safety. In addition, we train teachers and students in the dos and don'ts of healthy digital citizenship.
